1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The primary aim of this Memorandum is to establish a framework for collaboration to foster a shared educational agenda and joint research. Both parties commit to advancing science education through an integrated system of training, information, and documentation, ensuring a global reach for localized expertise.

2. AREAS OF COOPERATION

- **Educational Agenda:** Development of joint curricula, modernization of teacher-training programs, and alignment with global standards.
- **Joint Research:** Collaboration on scientific projects, shared publications, and participation in international research forums.
- **Ethical Foundation:** Promoting moral and intellectual solidarity, human rights, and social justice as the bedrock of all shared educational activities.

3. IMPLEMENTATION

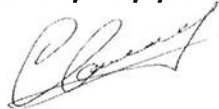
Specific activities, including resource sharing and staff/student exchanges, will be agreed upon on a case-by-case basis through supplementary agreements or specific project protocols.

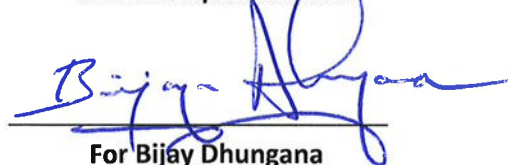

ADDENDUM: JOINT ACTION PLAN

INTENT FOR COLLABORATIVE ONLINE PROGRAMS

The Parties express their shared intent to launch the following specific initiatives within the first year of cooperation:

I. Online Seminar Series: Ethics for Civic Virtue & Societal Development

- **Focus:** Promoting integrity, active citizenship, and the role of ethics in rebuilding and strengthening society.
- **Objective:** To foster a dialogue on ethical leadership and the moral responsibilities of educators in times of societal transition.

II. Micro-Course Training: Up-to-Date ICT Skills & Competences

- **Focus:** Providing rapid upskilling in digital literacy, AI ethics, and modern educational technologies.
- **Objective:** To equip educators and students with practical, high-demand technical competencies aligned with the UNESCO ICT Competency Framework for Teachers.
