



MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION

Parties:

- **Party A:** UNESCO Chair on Science Education at Dragomanov Ukrainian State University (Kyiv, Ukraine).
 - **Party B:** Qatar-Ukraine Business Forum (QUBF) (Doha, Qatar).
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1. Purpose & Objectives

The primary goal is to establish a unique channel for knowledge exchange and collaborative educational initiatives.

- **Innovation in Learning:** Develop experiential and culturally embedded models of learning that move beyond conventional classroom instruction.
- **Strategic Market Alignment:** Facilitate the entry of Ukrainian educational technology (EdTech) and academic expertise into the Qatari market.
- **Sustainable Development:** Promote joint research and training in line with the International Day of Engagement in Science for Sustainable Development.

2. Key Areas of Cooperation

The parties agree to collaborate on the following high-priority initiatives:

- **Pilot Projects:** Implementation of the "Teaching & Learning with Living Heritage" pilot school in Qatar to integrate scientific inquiry with cultural heritage.
- **Professional Development:** Creating a portfolio of short courses and training programs for teachers, academic institutions, and gifted children.
- **Technology & AI:** Integrating world-class expertise in AI transformation, cybersecurity, and robotics into educational curricula.
- **Mobility & Exchange:** Organizing student and faculty exchanges, joint courses, and sharing expertise between UNESCO-affiliated programs in both countries.

3. Roles & Responsibilities

- **UNESCO Chair (Dragomanov Ukrainian State University):**
 - Provide the academic framework and validated methodologies for science education, teacher training, and the broader cooperation in the educational, scientific, and research spheres.
 - Supply experts and trainers for joint educational programs.
- **Qatar-Ukraine Business Forum (QUBF):**
 - Act as a catalyst for connecting the Chair with Qatari educational and other related authorities
 - Identify business opportunities and investment pathways for educational innovations in Qatar and Ukraine.

4. Terms of Agreement

- **Duration:** This MoC is valid for five (5) years and is subject to automatic extension unless terminated with six months' written notice.
- **Legal Nature:** This document serves as a statement of intent and does not create legally binding financial obligations.
- **Language:** Executed in two original copies in English and Ukrainian, both versions having equal legal value.
